

EOP Applicant Checklist

Indicate your interest in EOP on the Admissions Application or by calling our Admissions Office and submit high school transcripts (even if incomplete because you have not yet graduated)

Contact our Admissions Office to arrange a visit, or to attend an Open House (phone numbers below)

Submit an [EOP Verification Worksheet](#) to our Financial Aid Office

Apply for a Federal PIN Number at www.pin.ed.gov

Complete and submit a FAFSA (Federal PELL) application at www.fafsa.ed.gov (SUNY Canton's Federal School Code is 002855) as soon as possible after January 1st

Complete and submit a New York State TAP application at www.tapweb.org

Provide all income documentation to our Financial Aid Office

Submit your **final** high school and college transcripts to our Admissions Office by August 1st

Pay tuition deposit (and Room and Board deposit if living on campus)

Complete and submit all required health forms and immunization records

Complete and submit an [autobiography](#) to our EOP Office by August 1st

Complete and submit an EOP Contract {link} to our EOP Office by August 1st

Complete a personal interview with an EOP counselor before classes begin

Check your canton.edu email and UCanWeb for updates

Pay your SUNY Canton bill by the due date (usually August 1st)

Confirm attendance at EOP Orientation (email millermj@canton.edu) by August 1st

Attend **both** required EOP and Freshman Orientations

Complete the Accuplacer placement test **during EOP Orientation**

Enroll full-time (12 – 16 credit hours) including BASK 051, College Success Strategies

Obtain your official class schedule

Verify your EOP book money amount with our EOP Office before purchasing your books

Purchase your textbooks after participating in the EOP Orientation
