The procedure involves additional work requirements in the form of a written contract between student and faculty.

The student must submit the following paperwork to the Honors Program Coordinator within the first few weeks of the semester:

- A completed Honors Contract Form
- A copy of the regular course syllabus

To have any course count towards the Honors requirements, the course must be at least **3 credits**. In order for the course to count towards your Honors Program requirements, you need to earn at least a **B** in the course.
