- NYS English Regents score ≥ 75; or Verbal SAT score ≥ 420; or Reading and Writing ACT scores ≥ 17; or Transfer student who has already passes a college-level English course.
- Prepared to take GER Math
- Math A exam and at least one additional year of math; or Already passed Intermediate Algebra or equivalent.
