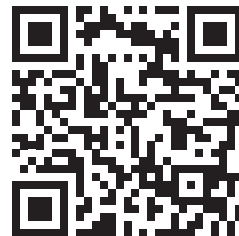

Admission Requirements:

- Prepared to take Expository Writing (ENGL 101)
- NYS English Regents score ≥ 75 ; or Verbal SAT score ≥ 420 ; or Reading and Writing ACT scores ≥ 17 ; or Transfer student who has already passes a college-level English course.
- Prepared to take GER Math
- Math A exam and at least one additional year of math; or Already passed Intermediate Algebra or equivalent.
