The North Country Regional Emergency Medical Advisory Committee (REMAC) has approved Ondansetron Hydrochloride (Zofran) as a regional option for ALS Agencies to use instead of Metoclopramide (Reglan) where indicated in the North Country EMS 2007 protocol book. Please see attached protocols.

All Critical Care and Paramedic providers **must** complete an online education program and test before they can administer Ondansetron Hydrochloride (Zofran). Agencies must keep a copy of the providers test in their files. Providers must achieve an 80% or better on test. Documented remediation must be provided by the training officer or the agency medical director if they achieve less than 80%.
