April finds us closing out the Spring 2015 semester and preparing to return for the Fall 2015 semester. This month is the best time to get your housing and class schedule set for next year!

Summer Aid

If you plan to enroll for the summer term and want to receive financial assistance, you must submit a summer financial aid application in addition to having a 2015-2016 FAFSA application already on file. Our Summer Aid page http://www.canton.edu/fin_aid/summer_aid.html has all the information you need, including the application, to understand the required steps to receiving summer financial aid.

Last Day to Withdraw

To withdraw from all coursework, paperwork must be submitted to the Registrar Office by 4:00 PM on Friday, April 17, 2015. This is your last chance to withdraw from any or all coursework for the Spring 2015 semester. Withdrawing from any course may impact your eligibility for financial aid in current or future semesters. You can view the basic information on the college withdrawal process and our brochure at http://www.canton.edu/student_accounts/withdraw.html. It is highly recommended that you sit down and discuss your options with both your Academic Advisor and your Financial Aid Advisor prior to withdrawing from all coursework.

Registration & Advising

Instructions will be sent to you by email from the Registrar Office as a reminder on how to properly register your courses for next semester. Make sure you meet with your Academic Advisor to plan your enrollment for Summer 2015 and/or the Fall 2015 semester. After meeting with your Academic Advisor you will receive a registration code and will need to enter your courses on UCanWeb using that code. Stay on track and only take courses required for your degree program. The amount of financial assistance you can receive is limited. In general students should enroll in 15 credits per semester to be able to graduate on time. Summer term is a good time to make up coursework!

Manage My ID

An online service for your student ID card in which you can view your account balances, view recent transactions, report your card lost/found, and make online deposits to your Roo Express account, instantly, by debit or credit card. It's simple to sign up. Go to managemyid.com, then you will need to select NY-SUNY Canton in the dropdown box and enter a little more information. All you need is your name, email address, and ID number to sign up. After you are registered, you will receive a confirmation link to the email address you supplied, and you will be all ready to go. Parents can make deposits into an account by clicking on the "Guest Deposit" option and entering in your ID number.

Don't forget to apply for 2015-2016 aid

By now you should have completed your FAFSA for the upcoming academic year. The 2015-2016 FAFSA application allows you to apply for financial aid for the Summer 2015, Fall 2015, Winter 2015, and Spring 2016 semesters. If you have not applied you still have plenty of time to apply at www.fafsa.gov. In addition to the application further documentation may be requested. Please monitor your UCanWeb account and SUNY Canton email for important notices about your student account.

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
