

TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT between SUNY CANTON and SUNY POTSDAM

ART STUDIO MAJOR with ART EDUCATION CERTIFICATION (K-GR12)

The purpose of this articulation agreement is to facilitate the transfer of Liberal Arts and Sciences: General Studies A.A. degree graduates from SUNY Canton to the Art Studio B.A. degree program at SUNY Potsdam with Art Education Certification (K-GR12). Students transferring with the General Studies degree will enter SUNY Potsdam as juniors and, assuming normal academic progress, have the opportunity to complete the B.A. degree in two additional years of full-time enrollment. Students are advised to follow specific course selection as indicated in the attached Appendix A degree completion chart.

The objectives, terms and conditions of this agreement are set forth as follows:

OBJECTIVES

- to attract qualified students to SUNY Canton and SUNY Potsdam.
- to facilitate upward educational and career mobility by increasing accessibility to baccalaureate education for qualified individuals.
- to provide students with advisement in academic and career planning throughout their program of study.
- to reduce unnecessary repetition of general education and curricular content by providing a seamless articulation opportunity.
- to facilitate communication, academic coordination between faculty, students and administrators at each institution.

ELIGIBILITY/ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- students transferring with an associate degree from SUNY Canton are guaranteed admission to SUNY Potsdam.
- students must complete the transfer admission process at SUNY Potsdam. Although admission to Potsdam is on a rolling admission basis, it is recommended that students complete the application process by October 1st for spring semester admission consideration and March 1st for fall semester admission consideration in order to be better served through the remainder of the enrollment, advising and registration process.
- students must have a 3.0 gpa in order to be admitted into the education certification professional sequence of courses and student teaching at St. Lawrence University.
- students must meet the academic requirements listed in the "Terms of Agreement".

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

TRANSFER ELIGIBILITY: Students who have completed the Liberal Arts and Sciences: General Studies A.A. degree program at SUNY Canton, with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale, will be accepted into the Art Studio B.A. degree program at SUNY Potsdam.

TRANSFER CREDIT/GRADES: All college-level courses from SUNY Canton transfer to SUNY Potsdam. Non-major courses with grades of "D" or higher will transfer, a "C" is required for all major and major cognate courses. Transferability of all SUNY Canton courses can be found at www.potsdam.edu/admissions/transfer/course equivalency tables.cfm. See Appendix A for a list of specific college level courses required to complete the B.A. degree with a major in Art Studio and Art Education Certification (K-GR12).

<u>IMPLEMENTATION/ADVISING</u>: Students will receive an official transfer credit evaluation upon acceptance to SUNY Potsdam. BearDen, Potsdam's electronic degree audit system will provide students with clear B.A. degree progress and degree completion information.

FINANCIAL AID: A student accepted into SUNY Potsdam under this agreement is eligible to participate in all financial aid, grants and scholarship programs available to transfer students.

PROGRAM CHANGES: If either SUNY Canton or SUNY Potsdam makes changes to their respective program, those changes will be communicated to the other college for review of this articulation agreement.
