Articulation Agreement Between State University of New York (SUNY) Canton and Greater Southern Tier BOCES

Effective dates: June 1, 2023 through May 31, 2028

Students receiving a course grade of **85%** or higher in the following BOCES course will be eligible to receive transfer credit through SUNY-Canton.






