



Articulation Agreement Between <u>State University of New York (SUNY) Canton</u> and <u>WEMOCO BOCES</u>

Effective dates: May 1, 2017 through April 30, 2022

The following document indicates how the courses taken at BOCES transfer into the programs noted. All transfer courses receive a grade of *TR* and are not used in computing the student's grade point average.

Students receiving a course grade of <u>85%</u>or higher in the following BOCES course will be eligible to receive transfer credit through SUNY-Canton's <u>Powersports Maintenance & Repair (Certificate)</u> program(s).

In addition to eligibility and admission requirements, students must also complete and pass with a grade of 85% or above, a competency test at SUNY Canton in order to receive credit for the above listed course.
