Articulation Agreement Between State University of New York (SUNY) Canton and Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES

Effective dates: February 1, 2021 through January 31, 2026

The following document indicates how the courses taken at BOCES transfer into the programs noted. All transfer courses receive a grade of *TR* and are not used in computing the student's grade point average.

Students receiving a course grade of "B", 80% or higher in the following BOCES course will be eligible to receive transfer credit through SUNY-Canton.






