Articulation Agreement Between State University of New York (SUNY) Canton and Nassau BOCES

Effective dates: September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2026

Students receiving a course grade of 85% or higher in the following BOCES course may be eligible to receive transfer credit through SUNY-Canton.






