Articulation Agreement Between State University of New York (SUNY) Canton and St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES

Effective dates: June 1, 2023 through May 31, 2028

The following document indicates how the courses taken at BOCES transfer into the programs noted. All transfer courses receive a grade of *TR* and are not used in computing the student's grade point average.

Students receiving a **cumulative course average of 85% or higher** in the following BOCES course(s) may be eligible to receive transfer credit through SUNY-Canton.


*Students must receive a minimum grade of 85% in each BOCES course which is to be transferred.


