Articulation Agreement Between State University of New York (SUNY) Canton and Western Suffolk BOCES

Effective dates: February 1, 2021 through January 31, 2026

The following document indicates how the courses taken at BOCES transfer into the programs noted. All transfer courses receive a grade of *TR* and are not used in computing the student's grade point average.

Students receiving a course grade of 90% or higher in the following BOCES course may be eligible to receive transfer credit through SUNY-Canton.

In addition to eligibility and admission requirements, students must also meet the following requirements in order to receive credit for the above listed courses:


- Present a CTE portfolio detailing construction activities completed




