What is Collaborate Ultra?

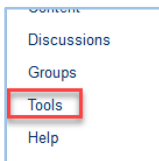
Collaborate Ultra is an online video conferencing tool offered in all SUNY Canton Blackboard courses. This tool allows an instructor to engage with their students in the digital realm, using an always available course room, or by creating their own sessions for each of your scheduled lectures.

How do I access Collaborate Ultra?

Your instructor will provide you with instructions how to access your Blackboard Collaborate Ultra course room or session.

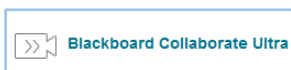
If your instructor would like you to access Collaborate Ultra through your course:

1. Log into Blackboard at canton.open.suny.edu with your Net ID and password.
2. Select your course from the “My Courses” module.
3. Navigate to the “Blackboard Collaborate Ultra” tool from the course menu > “Tools.”



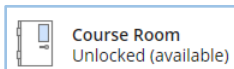

4. Select the “Blackboard Collaborate Ultra” tool from the tools available.

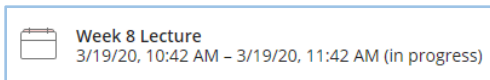
