6. Method of Selection and Arrangements for Financial Support of Exchange Visitor while in the U. S. (specify source and amount of funding, as appropriate.)

Short term scholars will be selected by the appropriate department. They will document minimum of \$7800 for a six month period provided by the scholar's government and/or home university. Students will be selected through SUNY Canton admissions as well as selection made through foreign academic institution. They will document at least \$2500, a summer program cost through personal funding. Participants of semester long programs will document minimum of \$11000 per semester (see attachments).

7. Purpose of Objective

The purpose for short term scholars is familiarization with the American higher education system, fostering collaboration and promoting exchange of ideas and pedagogies. Objective for students is to study in a traditional classroom setting as well as learn about American culture and improve English. Objective is also to facilitate cultural and social exchange between program participants and American students and faculty (see attachments).

8. Outline of Proposed Activities

In addition to required program activities, students will also engage in a comprehensive orientation program, cultural activities organized by SUNY Canton Student Activities, as well as area departmental organizations facilitated by faculty. All activities will promote cultural exchange, as they are open to the whole SUNY Canton community.

9. Arrangements for Supervision

In terms of program activity, designated faculty members will be supervising and mentoring short term scholars. The Office of International Initiatives will be responsible for SEVIS tracking and reporting requirements, and will be available to answer any status related questions. Students will reside in dorms and will be supervised by resident directors and assistants.

10. Role of Other Organizations Associated with Program (if any)

Student Services will support programs through student activities, College Association is responsible for meals, Residence Life overseas housing, Moscow State University office led by Dr. Olga Zinovieva for student screening and admission, other partner universities (see attachment).
