Garrett Construction, Inc., a premiere Naples builder and general contractor now in its 40<sup>th</sup> year of operation. He is also Chairman and CEO of LMGOF, the Lifestyle Management Group of Florida. Don is the current owner of The Club at Gateway, which was purchased from the members on Easter 2018.
