

Housing Release Policy:

All full-time students are required to live in the residence halls unless the Director of Residence Life has released them from the College mandatory residency policy. These students must also sustain a minimum of 12 credit hours to reside on campus. The College has authorized the Director to release individuals from the policy if they are married, single parents, residing with parents, students residing in College-approved fraternities or sororities, age 21 or older, part-time students, taking only online classes or enrolled in the Dental Hygiene program in Rome, New York. Also, the Director of Residence Life can release any student who is officially enrolled as a junior or senior in their Bachelor's degree program. **Due to the higher tuition rates paid by out-of-state and international students release requests not meeting the above criteria will be considered on a case-by-case basis for these students.** All other cases will be reviewed on an individual basis, and a judgment will be made by the Director of Residence Life as to whether the severity of the hardship warrants a release.
