Current Policy:

Children in Residence Halls

Children under 16 years of age are not permitted in the residence halls unless accompanied by a legal guardian, College employee, or a sibling who resides in the residence hall who is at least 18 years old. Under no circumstances is an individual under 16 years of age to be allowed in the residence halls after 9 p.m. or before 9 a.m., unless they are participating in a College organized program. An individual must be at least 16 years old and a full-time student to reside in the residence halls.

Suggested Policy Revision:

Children in Residence Halls

Children under 17 years of age are not permitted in the residence halls unless accompanied by a legal guardian, College employee, or a sibling who resides in the residence hall who is at least 18 years old. Under no circumstances is an individual under 17 years of age to be allowed in the residence halls after 9 p.m. or before 9 a.m., unless they are participating in a College organized program. An individual must be at least 16 years old and A full-time matriculated student who is 16 years of age may reside in the residence halls with guardian permission.
