- [9] US History & Civic Engagement
- [10] World History & GA
- [11] World Languages

One course can count in two categories of GER, but credits cannot be counted twice.

General Electives and Total Credits - Students must complete 45 upper-level credits and at least 120 credits total

3. Students must complete 30 credits at SUNY Canton to get a SUNY Canton degree.
