* Students planning to enter one of the Bachelors Degree programs should take a GER course. These students must have seven GERs.

** Writing Intensive Course (JUST 201)

-Introduction to Criminal Justice should be taken as soon as possible - is a pre-requisite for all other CJ/CI courses.

-MATH 106 Intermediate Algebra is the minimum level acceptable toward AAS degree (not transferrable to a 4-yr program). MATH 111 Survey of Math or MATH 121 College Algebra is minimum for B. Tech degrees.

-HIST 103 Early American History of HIST 105 Modern US History is recommended for the American History Elective.
