A minimum of 60 credit hours with a 2.0 GPA is required to receive the AAS degree in Criminal Justice. Students must take all of the PROGRAM courses and all courses in Emphasis A **OR** Emphasis B **OR** Emphasis C (**NOT ALL THREE**)

\* Students planning to enter one of the Bachelors Degree programs should take a GER course. These students must have seven GERs.

\*\* Writing Intensive Course (JUST 201)

-Introduction to Criminal Justice should be taken as soon as possible – is a pre-requisite for all other CJ/CI courses.

-MATH 106 Intermediate Algebra is the minimum level acceptable toward AAS degree (not transferrable to a 4-yr program). MATH 111 Survey of Math or MATH 121 College Algebra is minimum for B. Tech degrees.

-HIST 103 Early American History or HIST 105 Modern US History is recommended for the American History Elective.

-Electives should be chosen to enrich the student's academic, personal or occupational pursuits. The following courses are encouraged:
