



# BLUE LIGHT EMERGENCY PHONE SYSTEM

An emergency phone system has been installed on campus to make the reporting of serious incidents easier and quicker. Although State University of New York at Canton is a relatively safe campus, you may find it necessary to contact the University Police Department to report an emergency, crime in progress or, a suspicious person or incident.

Each emergency phone box is attached to a light pole or building. A blue light, easily seen at night, hangs over each box. To report an incident, depress the clearly labeled "PUSH" button for immediate connection to the University Police Department. Tell the officer the number printed on the box, i.e. #1, #2, #3, etc.

When reporting an incident, try to remain calm and report:

- What is happening (*assault, break-in*)
- Where is the incident (*plaza, island*)
- When did it happen (*1 minute ago, 1/2 hr. ago*)
- Who is involved (*college age males, teenagers*)

Try to remember as much identifying information and descriptions as possible.

#### Persons

- name (if known)
- sex
- age
- skin color
- height, weight
- clothing
- physical impairments
- method of escape

#### Vehicles

- license plate #
- make, model, color
- rust spots, dents
- # of occupants
- which way it went

#### Weapons

- gun-pistol, rifle
- knife-type and length
- other weapons

#### Property

- serial numbers
- complete detailed description

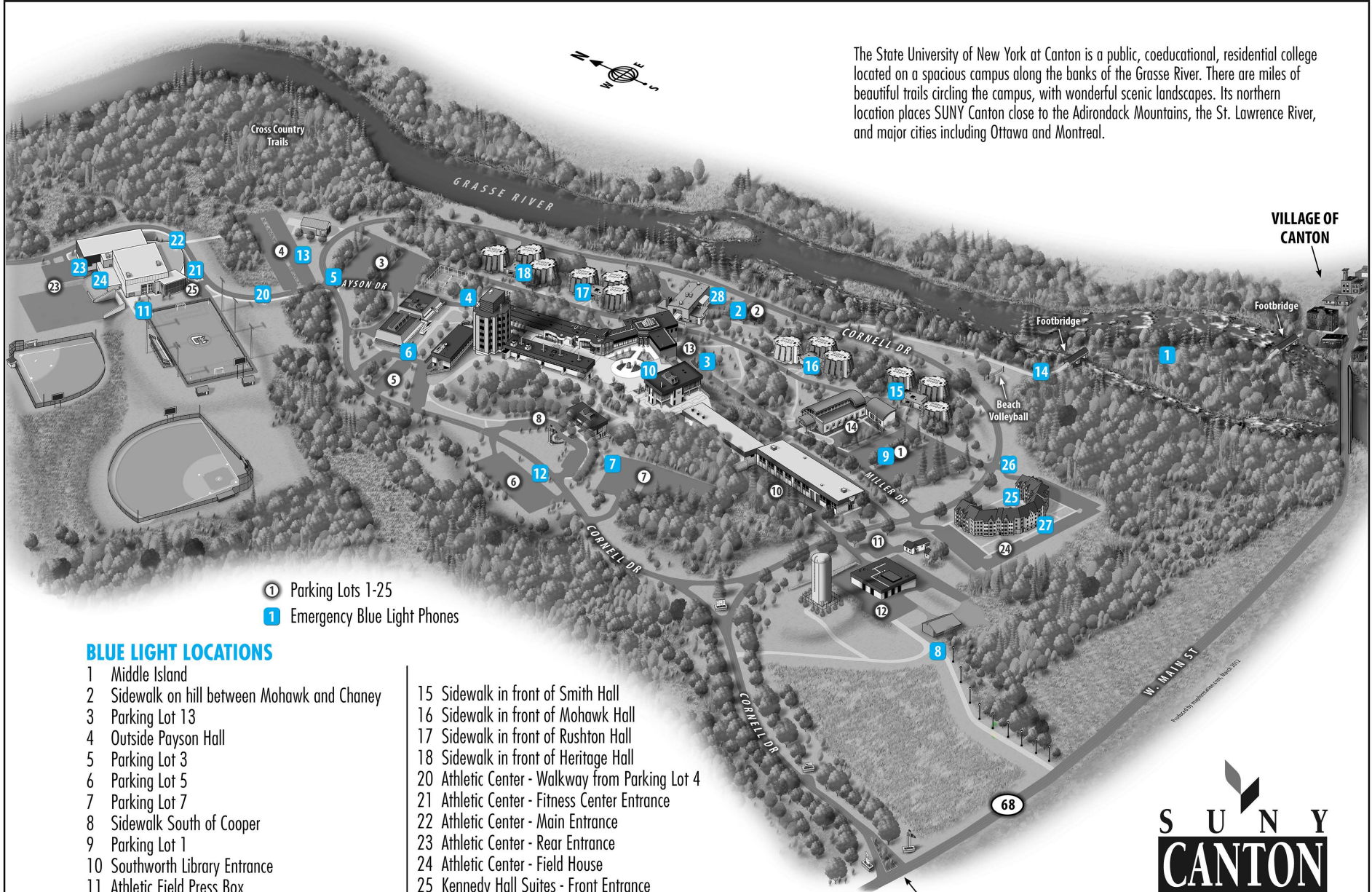
