




I was in high school and unsure how to handle the situation. The high school I attended did not handle situations like this very well.




Do you feel the college would take a report of sexual assault seriously?




Do you feel the college would take steps to protect the safety of the person making the report?




Do you feel that if a crisis happened, the college would handle the incident in a fair and responsible manner? (Respondents could only choose a **single** response)
