
RSVP FOR COMMENCEMENT!!

Excelsior Scholarship Application 2023-2024 is now OPEN!

Instructions for NEW Applicants: The application for the Fall 2023 semester is coming. Keep an eye on your email or check out HESC's website for more information. To apply you must complete the application process atwww.hesc.ny.gov/excelsior including providing any documentation requested by the state. The award amount you can receive is up to \$3,235 per semester for full-time New York State residents whose 2021 family adjusted gross income was less than \$125,000. The amount of the scholarship award is determined after all other grants and scholarships have been deducted from the cost of tuition. To help understand the process, here is an outline of the application process flow:

- 1. Student files their 2023-2024 FAFSA and NYS TAP applications.
- 2. Student completes the Excelsior Scholarship Application with NYS HESC.
- 3. NYS HESC contacts SUNY Canton to confirm academic credit and enrollment status.
 - 4. SUNY Canton transmits data to NYS HESC.
 - 5. NYS HESC processes information and notifies student of eligibility.
 - 6. If eligible, student must complete and submit the contract to NYS HESC.
 - 7. NYS HESC processes contract and notifies SUNY Canton of approval.
- 8. SUNY Canton receives a weekly list and determines amount of the scholarship based on other awards.
- 9. If ineligible for an award amount, SUNY Canton notifies student. Any students who misses the Fall 2023 application deadline cannot receive the award for this semester. They may however still apply for the scholarship when the application opens for the following spring semester.

Important Notice for CURRENT Recipients:

If you are currently receiving the Excelsior Scholarship then you do not need to follow the process above and can easily renew your award simply by checking the Excelsior box on your TAP application for 2023-2024.

There is still time to apply for 2023-2024

Financial Aid It's not too late to apply. You are behind schedule which means it is especially important that you submit all applications as soon as possible and respond timely to any requests for additional information. Be sure to complete all of the following:

Submit the FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov to apply for federal assistance including loans.

New York State assistance is available for NYS Residents.

Submit the TAP at www.tapweb.org to apply for the TAP Grant.

Submit the Excelsior Scholarship application at www.hesc.com/excelsior (once the application is available) to apply for additional tuition assistance.

Fall Billing 2023 Are you ready for your fall semester bill?

We plan to begin billing for the fall semester on Wednesday June 28th. (Bill notifications will be sent your SUNY Canton email!)

1.Schedule all of your fall semester courses.

Remember, waitlisted courses **do not count** toward your registered hours.

- 2. Notify the financial aid office if you are changing from Full Time to Part Time (or vice versa).
 - 3. Complete the housing application or apply for release.
 - 4. Complete all missing financial aid requirements.
 - 5. Resolve any holds on your student account.
 - 6. Submit any missing academic transcripts.
 - 7. Check your SUNY Canton email for important notices.

Payments

ONLINE: Pay by credit card or electronic withdrawal from a checking or savings account online in Transact Payments Portal | Parent / Authorized Payer Access.

PAPER CHECK: Make check payable to 'SUNY Canton'. Be sure to include the student's 9 digit Banner ID. Remit payment to SUNY Canton, 34 Cornell Dr., MCC Room 012, Canton, NY 13617

INTERNATIONAL PAYMENTS: SUNY Canton has partnered with <u>Flywire</u> to provide international students with an easy and secure method for sending international payments. Or pay online by credit card or electronic withdrawal from a checking or savings account online in <u>Transact Payments Portal</u>.

Health Insurance Waiver

The Medical Insurance Waiver opens on June 28th.

The Waiver can be completed on UCanWeb and must be submitter by the second week of classes in order to have the health insurance charge removed from their bill. Part-time students may also purchase health insurance, but need to request to have it added to their bill.

Billing Office (Student Accounts)

Student Refunds are issued through BankMobile Disbursements (BMTX). Make sure you have your bank account preference set up to avoid delays!
