Summer Courses for 2023

Course Registration begins on Monday,

March 6 @ 8:00 am

Contact your advisor to discuss whether summer courses are right for you and to obtain your registration code. The workload of summer courses is equivalent to a full semester condensed into a smaller time frame. SUNY Canton degree students may enroll in a maximum of nineteen (19) credit hours during the summer session.

Summer courses begin on June 1 for Session I and II AND July 13 for Session III. See the schedule of classes in <u>UCanWeb</u> for more information

If requesting financial aid, <u>a summer application is re-</u> <u>quired</u>. Please note the Excelsior Scholarship cannot be used for summer sessions.

DEADLINE is March 15, 2023. If you are planning to graduate in May 2023, make sure to let us know your plans!

Financial Aid & Enrollment

To apply for Summer 2023 financial aid you must complete these steps:

1.File the 2023-2024 FAFSA form.

2.Provide us with any additional documentation that is required. Watch your email for notices and check your <u>UCanWeb account</u> for financial aid requirements.

3. File your TAP application with NYS HESC. View your current TAP Status online.

4. Meet with your Academic Advisor and schedule your summer courses in your UCan-Web account.

5. **Complete the <u>Summer Financial Aid Application</u>**. Be sure to read all of the guidelines and submit the completed form to the One Hop Shop.

6. Login to your UCanWeb account and complete the summer billing forms. Review the <u>summer billing instructions</u> for details.

7. Watch your SUNY Canton email for follow-up notifications from the One Hop Shop.

We will notify you by email what summer assistance you have been offered.

8.Once your summer financial aid has been determined, you must confirm your acceptance and pay any remaining balance due on your account.

9.Be sure to watch your SUNY Canton email for updates! Your summer registration

will not be official until your bill has been paid and/or covered by financial aid.

BILLING

Session I & II, classes begin June 1: Bill due by 3:00 PM June 1

Session III, classes begin July 13: Bill due by 3:00 PM on July 13*

*Students registered for BOTH **Summer** Session I or II courses as well as Summer Session III courses will have a billing deadline of June 1 at 3:00 PM regardless of their Session III courses starting at a later date.

Failure to have your bill processed by the billing due date may result in a \$40 late fee and your course schedule being dropped.

You are not officially registered for a semester until your bill is processed.

ROO Express for Summer

A Roo Express account is a discretionary spending account to use at the textbook center, campus store, and all dining facilities. You can request an amount up to \$55 per credit hour for the Winterterm If your bill is able to be covered without requested Roo Express (i.e. Roo Express is causing a balance due), you must pay that balance. The Student Accounts Office has the ability to lower the amount of or cancel Roo Express to process a bill.
