Starting Tuesday, August 29, 2023, you need to follow the <u>Course Change Re</u><u>quest process</u> to add or withdraw from a course for the Fall 2023 semester.

Instructions can be found here for how to start the process in UCanWeb.

Please note that this is a **TWO STEP** process. You must initiate the request. Then your request to add or drop the class goes for approval as appropriate (your instructor, advisor and/or dean's office). If your request is approved, you **MUST then confirm that is still your intent by logging back into UCanWeb and going to Course Change Request Outcome.** Be vigilant in checking UCanWeb to track the progress of your request.

NOTES:

- <u>There is a \$20 processing fee on each request you submit. This fee will</u> <u>automatically be added to your bill.</u>
- Please make sure you are carefully reading all of the emails you receive related to your requests.

Pay attention to campus deadlines by reviewing the Academic Calendar

If you intend to **withdraw from ALL classes this semester**, that is a different process. <u>Those instructions are HERE</u>.

Request to Pass or Fail

Wednesday, Sept. 20th @ 4pm

The deadline for students to request a Pass/Fail Option is 3 weeks from the date the course begins for full 15-week courses.

The deadline for students to request a Pass/Fail Option is 1 week from the date courses begin for any course which is NOT a regular, full 15-week course All deadlines are published on the Academic Calendar, no late submissions will be accepted.

Engaged/Not Engaged Status: Friday, Sept. 15th @ 9:00am

Engaged/Not Engaged flags are added to each student per course during the third week of classes.

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid process is going to look a bit different than it was in the past. Please watch your emails and mail for information on the changes!

Adding/Dropping Courses—Impact on Financial Aid

Before adding or dropping any course(s), you should consult both your Academic Advisor and the Financial Aid Staff. Our staff will review your account to see how changes to your schedule may impact your current and future financial aid eligibility. Don't assume because a friend was told they would be okay that your account will be. The impact on your student account may be different than other students. Different aid has different requirements for maintaining eligibility. If you withdraw from all coursework, than a recalculation of all financial aid will be required.

Are you taking a class not required by your current degree program?

In order to receive financial aid to help pay for your courses, the course must be applicable toward the degree program you are in for the semester you are taking the course. Aid will only cover coursework applicable to the degree program as a general education requirement, a major requirement, or elective (whether restricted or free elective).

In addition to these requirements, you should always be aware of the minimum number of credits and GPA requirement you must maintain in order to continue receiving financial aid each semester. A copy of the <u>Satisfactory Academic Progress</u> <u>Guidelines</u> chart is available in the One Hop Shop as well as on our webpage.






Health Insurance Waiver

The Medical Insurance deadline is Friday, September 22nd!

If you have current medical insurance coverage, then you can request that the health insurance charge be waived. **If you are a new student**, **you must have your SUNY Canton email account set up to waive the health insurance.** United Health Care will issue you a 6-digit code that will be emailed to your SUNY Canton email account that you will need in order to waive your coverage.
