

President's Cabinet Charge

Membership

The President's Cabinet (PC) shall consist of the following individuals:

- President
- Provost
- Vice President for Administration
- Vice President for Advancement
- Vice President for Student Affairs
- Executive Director for Strategic Initiatives & Legislative Affairs
- Executive Assistant to the President

Charge

The President's Cabinet has the following major tasks. Other duties may also be assigned.

- Provide broader perspectives and recommendations to the president on campus-wide issues.
- Review the draft budget in July of each year and reach consensus about any necessary changes in it. Make a final budget recommendation to the president.
- Review and make recommendations regarding proposed promotions and raises for all staff members to the president.
- Make final decisions on implementation of SUNY and State initiatives, mandates, and salary adjustments.
- Review and make recommendations regarding all new official College policies and procedure, as well as significant changes in existing policies and procedures, to the president.
- As *ex officio* members of the Executive Cabinet, help review and make recommendations regarding Faculty Assembly resolutions to President.
- Make presentations and reports about their respective areas at meetings of the College Council and address issues arising therein.
- Respond to issues impacting their respective areas at Labor Management meetings.
- Make final recommendations to the president regarding Strategic Initiative Proposals recommended by the Executive Cabinet, both as to *whether* they should be implemented and funded, as well as the *manner and timeline* in which they should be funded.
- Make final recommendations to the president regarding addressing and funding accessibility issues recommended by the Executive Cabinet.

Meeting Frequency

The President's Cabinet shall meet weekly.
