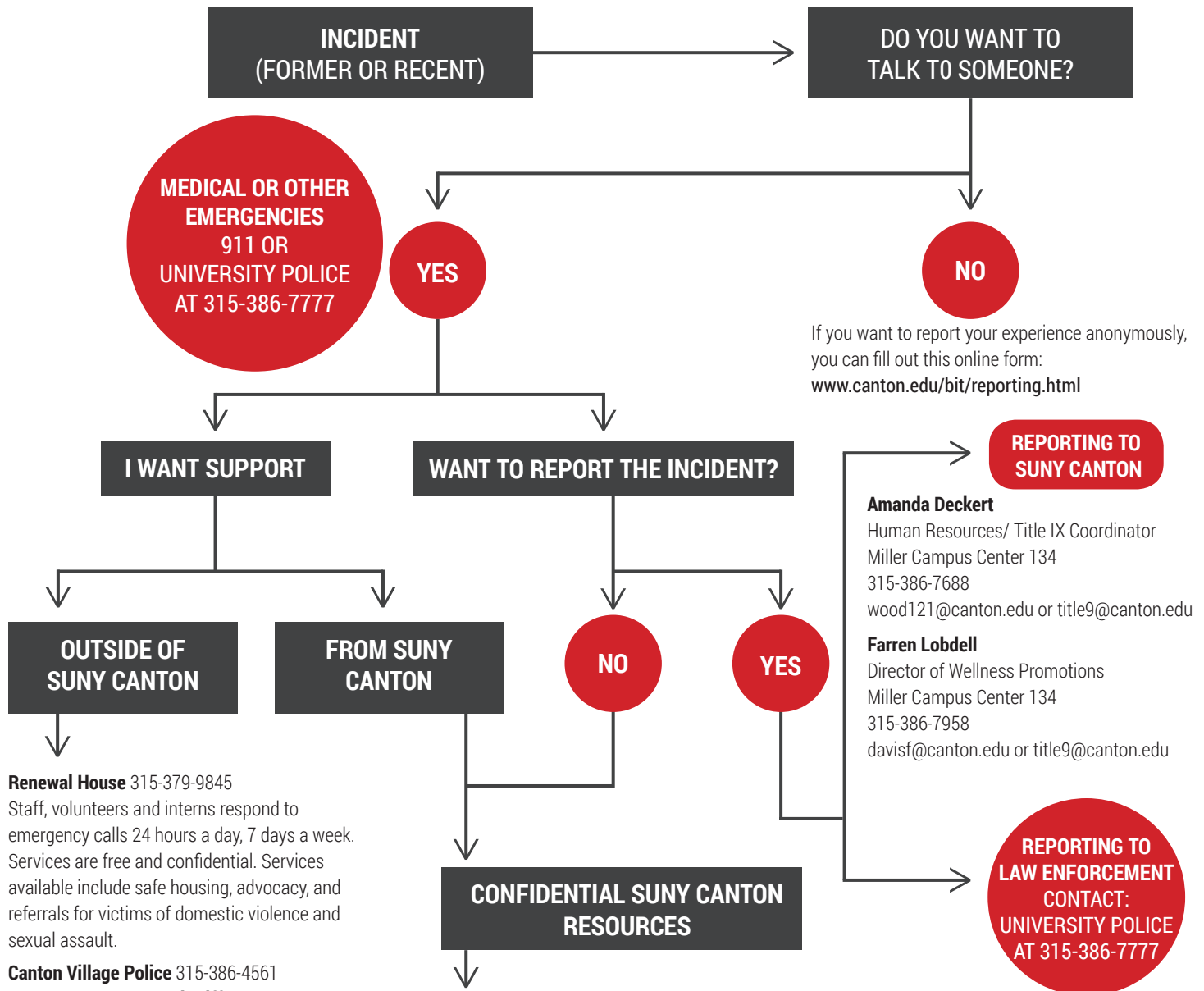


# TITLE IX SUPPORT AND REPORTING OPTIONS

Confidential crises counseling is available. If you have been sexually assaulted (recently or in the past) or are the victim of an attempted assault, the Counseling Center staff is available to talk to you and will help you sort through the issues. They will listen, offer understanding, help clarify your immediate and future concerns, link you with a support system, and assist you with legal reporting dealing with any long-term effects of an assault including anxiousness, depression, eating or sleeping problems, and fears. If you need to speak to a counselor after the office is closed, contact University Police at 386-7777 and the dispatcher will contact a counselor for you immediately.
