You do not have to use the AACU rubric to assess these objectives. Only the courses listed in the Program Assessment Plans below are expected to use the AACU Value Rubrics.

- 2. If you course **DID NOT** complete the ISLO assessment for the fall you will need to complete the AACU rubric for the spring. You will need to **select one course level SLO** that maps to either Communication, Critical Thinking or both (see the list above) and create an AACU rubric with the assignment description.
- 3. If your spring 2017 course is not on the SLO 1 and SLO 2 lists above you **DO NOT** need to assess anything this spring.
